COVID-19 Discussion:

- Some libraries are allowing patrons in other communities. Our patrons can visit those libraries as we are part of the consortium.

Director's Report:

- Bats have not been a problem. However, mice are beginning to be a problem. The staff will let Freedom Pest Control know when they check in this month.
- MLS Children's Librarians are meeting monthly. MVLC meeting every two months. Cathy has been attending.
- Budget: Michele Augeri has been doing the bills. Staff is continually spending. Also starting to spend the LSTA Grant.
- Shelving bill had some issues as the town needed a copy of the bill. Payment schedule
 is determined by the town. Michele is working with the town to get the paperwork the
 town needs.
- Library will close at 5:00pm instead of 6:00pm on Wednesday before Thanksgiving and closed the day after on Friday.

New Business

- Mary reports they are stopping the Bag Book Sale outside but still available inside if they
 happen to make an appointment. Bags are available by donation for different genres of
 books.
- Friends hired a pruning expert, Jen Kettell, Radiant Leaf, to teach some volunteers to care for the Michele Patten gardens. Hopefully less trees will hold snow this winter and hang over the sidewalk.
